

# West Midlands Clinical Chemistry Training Scheme

## Recording of audio lectures

For the 2008-9 lecture programme the course will attempt to create a record of the lectures. This is primarily to support the production of an e-learning environment for current and future students.

The recording will take the format of audio capture of the lecture and will only be made if the presenter has given their prior permission. No equipment or special requirements are envisaged for the host venue or the day organiser.

Presenters will be fitted with a small portable radio microphone, which is discreet and easily carried. The presenter is therefore free to move around and present without interference. There will be a slight delay before each presentation as each presenter is "miked up". The equipment should not interfere with any fixed PA systems or lectern microphone systems that may be in use in some venues.



The microphone is a wireless radio microphone, which will send the signal to a recording device in the lecture room. If the recording fails for any technical reason the presenter will be informed after the talk so as not to interrupt the presentation in any way.

Recordings may then be made available to current students or utilised in the e-learning environment again with permission of the presenter.



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
